TERMS & CONDITIONS

The signature/authorization of the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) on the Application Form or the Re-enrollment Form implies the acceptance of the conditions set out in this schedule.

Admission:

Reservation and acceptance of a student's space can only be **confirmed after payment of the application fee or re-enrollment fee**, and submission of all application materials and supporting documents.

In cases classes have waiting lists, full application fee, is still due.

Withdrawals and Refunds:

Withdrawals before January 1st: Tuition and bus service fees are not reimbursable unless the school is notified in writing (registered letter with return receipt) by October 31st of the current school year that a student will be leaving the school before January 1st. If the latter condition were met, the family would be entitled to reimbursement of 50% of the school year's tuition and bus service fee. Other fees (application, capital assessment and re-enrollment) are not reimbursed.

Withdrawals after January 1st: Withdrawals after January 1st are not reimbursed.

There will be no refund for tuition, either in whole or in part, for any absence or dismissal.

Unpaid tuition fees may result in students being suspended from school. No report cards, transcripts or diplomas will be released until all financial commitments to the school have been met. In case of failure to pay, the account is transferred to a recovery agency.

- Acceptance of students will be confirmed after reception of the payment of application/re-enrollment fee and supporting documents
- Capital Assessment Fee is a one-time fee charged the first year a student attends Marymount. These funds are directed toward maintaining the Marymount heritage buildings, upgrading them as well as grounds and equipment.
- Tuition fees include an annual set of school supplies and constant use of technology supplies. Curriculum related mandatory field trips and May trips are also included in tuition.
- Payment conditions: Students arriving before January 1st pay full annual tuition. Students arriving after January 1st pay two thirds of annual tuition. Full tuition and other fees are payable in one installment before July 1st, 2016.
- Hot Lunch Program: There will be no deduction or refund of lunch fees, either in whole or in part for absences, withdrawal or dismissal. The hot lunch program will be prorated from start date in case of late arrival.
- Bus Service: Students arriving after January 1st pay two thirds of the Bus Service fee.
